2023-24 NAHB Student Chapter Scholarship Program

ELIGIBILITY

With the support of the Pennsylvania Housing Research Center (PHRC), National Association of Home Builders (NAHB), the Pennsylvania Builders Association (PBA), and industry stakeholders, a scholarship program has been established. Penn State NAHB Student Chapter members who are interested in financial support are encouraged to apply for a scholarship. Consideration for scholarships will be given to Penn State students who are interested in and have a commitment to housing. **Students must be members of the Penn State NAHB Student Chapter in 2023-24 to be eligible. Scholarship applications will be accepted until **Friday, Sept. 29 at 5:00 p.m. ET**; no late or incomplete applications will be accepted. The Hankin Committee will vote on the scholarship submissions. Scholarship winners will be announced on November 2 at the NAHB Student Chapter Awards Banquet, and scholarships will be awarded in January 2024 directly into students' accounts. The NAHB Student Chapter Awards Banquet will be held on Nov. 2 at the Hintz Family Alumni Center, and scholarship applicants should plan to attend. Students applying for a scholarship must complete the requirements listed below.

REQUIREMENTS

All applicants applying for a SCHOLARSHIP must submit one .PDF file containing the following in order:

- 1) a completed "Scholarship Application Form"
- 2) an "Unofficial Transcript" through Summer 2023
- 3) an "Academic Course Plan" (list of courses you plan to take for your remaining time at Penn State)
- 4) a 2-pg. statement of "Career Objectives" (both short- & long-term) and their connection with housing. This statement should indicate how your objectives relate to the residential and light-commercial building construction industry (i.e., family ties to the industry, desire to work for a residential development or engineering/surveying firm associated with the industry, desire to manage one's own firm, etc.). Be sure to include any other pertinent information such as:
 - a) your work-related experiences (including part-time, summer, etc.)
 - b) your involvement in the NAHB Student Chapter (including NAHB Student Competition, Solar Decathlon Design Challenge, service with Habitat for Humanity of Greater Centre County, etc.)
 - c) honors or awards that you have received
 - d) residential design, construction, and/or real estate courses that you have completed at any institution
 - e) some indication of your financial situation (i.e., financial need if you wish to do so)
